

## The funerary inscription from Bēšābūr

ēn haspvar  
anōšruvān panāh(-veh ?)  
ī māhdād ašō  
xšēš u-š  
vahišt ī pahlum bavād

‘This tomb belongs to the immortal-souled Panāh(-veh), son of Māhdād the truthful; and may the best Paradise be his (lot).’
